What Is Your Purpose in Life?: Living Out Your Purpose

In last week's newsletter, you may remember reading an article answering a difficult question: "Why was I born?" The answer was found in God's word, and in a nutshell, your purpose "is to love and worship God, and show the same love He offers us to others so they too can come to know Him." This week, our *Gospel Project Daily Discipleship Guide* reminded us how we are to live out this purpose, as follows:

Social Concern: *All Christians are under obligations to seek to make the will of Christ supreme in our own lives and in human society. Means and methods used for the improvement of society and the establishment of righteousness among men can be truly and permanently helpful only when they are rooted in the regeneration of the individual by the saving grace of God in Jesus Christ. In the Spirit of Christ, Christians should oppose racism, every form of greed, selfishness, vice, and all forms of sexual immorality, including adultery, homosexuality, and pornography. We should work to provide for the orphaned, the needy, the abused, the aged, the helpless, and the sick. We should speak on behalf of the unborn and contend for the sanctity of all human life from conception to natural death. Every Christian should seek to bring industry, government, and society as a whole under the sway of the principles of righteousness, truth, and brotherly love. In order to promote these ends, Christians should be ready to work with all men of good will in any good cause, always being careful to act in the spirit of love without compromising their loyalty to Christ and His truth (Micah 6:8; Ephesians 6:5-9; 1 Thessalonians 3:12).*

Reading these words should serve as a reminder of who we are as his people: those who stand up for the holy, inspired word of God, and to lovingly respond to those who oppose Him with grace and truth.

For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God, you may receive what is promised — Hebrews 10:36

Living the faithful life of a Christian is not always easy. In fact, Christians will struggle, face challenges, and will be tempted and tested in their beliefs. However, remember that Jesus persevered all the way to death so that we could live in His abundant life. Our earthly life is good because God is good and His rewards are great for the ones who persevere to the very end.
