## Lessons for Our Fathers from The Father

The role of an earthly father originated with God Himself, our Heavenly Father, and is a divine calling. Becoming a father, stepfather, grandfather, or foster father is an opportunity to become more like God: to love and care for his children just as God loves and cares for us. As we joyfully celebrate Father's Day this Sunday, let's remember the biblical connection between our earthly fathers and our Heavenly Father.

***Train up a child in the way he should go so that even when he is old, he will not depart from it — Proverbs 22:6***

Like our Father God, fathers should always be there for their children, just like He is for us. Fathers may not always agree with their children, but they should always be there to love and care for them, just like our best friend, Jesus. A father's love is sacrificial, patient, kind, humble, honest, forgiving, faithful, and selfless; much like Jesus in the way he loved and sacrificed His life for us on the cross. The role of our earthly fathers is to provide, protect, discipline, teach right from wrong, encourage, motivate, promote good behaviors and to demonstrate honesty, respect and humility, just as our Heavenly Father does according to His holy word, the Bible.
