You may be interested in knowing that the first recorded Protestant Sunday school opened in 1751 in *St. Mary's Church*, Nottingham, England. Generous Christians wanted to provide an education to poor children who were working in factories during the week. The school met on Sunday; thus the name. Parents were very pleased for their children to learn to read and write from the Bible, which was their textbook.


