Remembering a Life Well Lived in Service to Our Lord

On Thursday, May 16, 2024, a seven-foot bronze likeness of Billy Graham was unveiled in *Statuary Hall* at the U.S. Capitol in Washington, D.C. The statue, sculpted by Charlotte-based artist Chas Fagan, features two Bible verses (*John 3:16* & *John 14:6*) along with the words, *Preacher of the Gospel of Jesus Christ* on its base. In Graham’s left hand is an open Bible with his right hand pointing to it. The dedication ceremony included dignitaries such as House Speaker Mike Johnson, Senator Ted Budd, Senator Tom Tillis, Congresswoman Virginia Foxx, and Governor Roy Cooper, who shared Billy Graham’s impact on both our nation and on their personal lives as well.

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me” — John 14:6

Billy Graham believed that the Bible is the inspired word of God, and therefore, inerrantly true. Throughout his messages, He repeatedly used the words, “the Bible says.” Indeed, Billy Graham was “a preacher of the gospel of Jesus Christ.” Through his more than 400 Crusades, simulcasts, and evangelistic rallies, Billy Graham preached the gospel message to some 215 million people in 185 countries and territories.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life — John 3:16

May we give thanks to our Father God for the impact Billy Graham had, not only in our own lives, but in the lives of millions of others around the world who found Jesus as their Savior through his preaching.

CRBC’s Financial Situation

In the past year, CRBC has incurred approximately \$55,000 in HVAC / Building & Grounds repairs. Because of the cost of these repairs, our church is currently in a financial crisis. We are asking two things from those who love CRBC: First, we ask you to give sacrificially. If you are not tithing, we ask that you start.
