#### Forgiving So We Can Forget

These dangerous feelings can change our mood, our behavior, our words, and even our blood pressure. More importantly, it can take away our godly joy.

Saying we forgive someone is relatively easy; it's just a matter of words. Truly forgiving someone is so much more difficult; it is a matter of the heart. Jesus gave us the ultimate example of forgiveness as He dealt with those who persecuted Him on the cross when He prayed for his Father God to forgive them.

## For I will forgive their iniquity and their sins. I will remember them no more. Jeremiah 31:34b

Forgiving someone is hard enough, but what about trying to forget this hurt, disappoint, and pain? God created us in His image and designed us to be like Him, reflecting his character in the way we live. To forgive & forget may be difficult, but it is not impossible. When we forgive &

forget, we are showing both the goodness and the greatness of God as He chooses to forgive us and remember our sins no more.
