Monday was a special day we set aside to remember our fallen heroes who lost their lives while serving in the U.S. Military. *Decoration Day* began in the years following the brutal Civil War, which killed so many soldiers that it required the establishment of the country's first national cemeteries. In 1868, Union General John A. Logan called for a national day of remembrance on

May 30th of each year. This special day was held at *Arlington National Cemetery* where about 5,000 people placed flowers at the graves of more than 20,000 Civil War soldiers. Over the decades, this holiday would evolve to include World Wars I & II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, and the wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. The name was changed to *Memorial Day*. Today, approximately 400,000 veterans and their eligible dependents are buried at *Arlington National Cemetery* over its 639 acres.

As Christians, when we think of the sacrifice these men & women so honorably gave for our country, our hearts and minds turn to the greatest sacrifice ever given. But unlike the fallen, Jesus rose from his grave, demonstrating His power over sin and death, and now sits on the right hand of the Father in heaven making intercession for us. We give praises to Jesus Christ who willingly laid down His life that we might be saved and have everlasting life. We are called to carry the fight as soldiers of the cross, wearing his righteousness while doing battle with sin.

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world... our faith — 1 John 5:4

Since his resurrection, millions of Christians have been martyred for their faith. Even today, our freedoms as Christians are under attack. And someday, we may even lose them. So, we must use our freedom each and every day to advance the cause of Christ while we can. Even though our earthly battles are not over, we have already won the war, because our victory is in Jesus alone. Thank you Lord Jesus!
